Your mark will be based on the quality of the information and the knowledge you demonstrate in the presentation you share with us.

Procedure

Step 1 – Decide if you want to work alone or with a partner – **Pick Carefully!!**

Step 2 - Research different first nations groups.

Step 3 – Decide on which group you want to complete a report on.

Step 4 – Meet with your teacher to get approval for your project.

Step 5 – Start organizing your ideas/topics/concepts so that they make sense.

Step 6 – Complete your work with great care.

What should be in our presentation?

- 1) The name of your First Nations Group with their emblem – **very important!!**
- 2) Contact Information – **very important!!**
- 3) Name of the Chief and Councilors – **very important!!**
- 4) Websites where you can find information.
 - a. Do they have their own website?
 - b. If they do, use the information they have on the site for your report.
- 5) Where do they live in Alberta – A Map showing where they live would be GREAT! – **very important!!**
 - a. Are they on a reserve?
 - b. Is there more than one town on the reserve?
- 6) History of the First Nations Group – **very important!!**
- 7) Language – **very important!!**
 - a. What is their traditional language?
 - b. Translate a few words for us
- 8) Schools
 - a. Do they have schools?
 - b. Give us some information about the schools?
 - i. Grades taught
 - ii. Locations
 - iii. Address
 - iv. Contact Information
 - v. Picture
- 9) Other interesting information that you thought we should know about – **very important!!**
